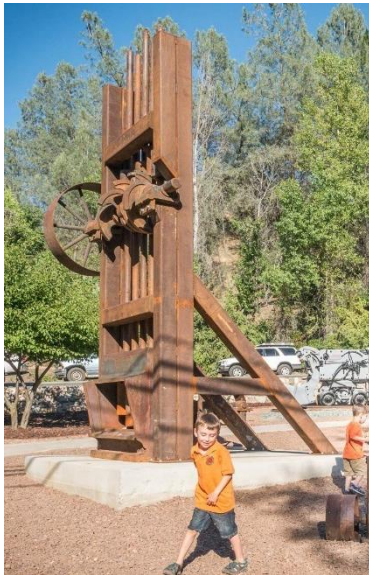
## WORK WITH YOUR NEIGHBORS
