Declaring a Local Emergency in Amador City Due to Localized Flooding and Extreme
Winds**

RESOLUTION 607

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AMADOR CITY DECLARING A LOCAL EMERGENCY IN AMADOR CITY DUE TO LOCALIZED FLOODING AND EXTREME WINDS

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 8630 empowers the City Council to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the City is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity; and

WHEREAS, since December 29, 2022 Amador City, along with many jurisdictions in California, has experienced winter storms delivering high winds and excessive rainfall as a result of a series of atmospheric rivers; and

WHEREAS, winter storms will continue well past the middle of January, 2023, bringing considerable new rainfall to already saturated land; and

WHEREAS, the ongoing winter storms have caused significant damage to City property with more potential for damage in the upcoming days; and

WHEREAS, on January 1, 2023, the Director of Emergency Services of the County of Amador proclaimed a local emergency based on conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within Amador County caused by floods and storms that began on December 29th, 2022 and is expected to be ongoing, currently threatening numerous structures, homes, land in Amador County, and said proclamation is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, on Wednesday January 3, 2023, California Governor Gavin Newsom declared a state of emergency in response to a powerful atmospheric river storm forecast to pound Northern California with heavy rain, snow and extremely gusty winds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Amador City hereby finds that there continues to exist within the City of Amador City conditions of disaster or extreme peril to the safety of persons and property that are beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the City, for the reasons set forth in Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the proclamation of a Local Emergency by the Director of Emergency Services of the County of Amador is hereby ratified, and that said Local Emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist until its termination is proclaimed by the City Council of the City of Amador City.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the State Director of the Officer of Emergency Services.
